Mental Health First Aid can help if you're struggling to cope with stress, having difficulties parenting, concerned you don't have food or basic supplies, or feeing lonely or hopeless. Responders can talk through your concerns and connect you to resources.

Mental health crisis services are available 24/7 for adults and children. Crisis teams can help over the phone, meet you in the community, and provide connections to services and resources.
